2017-2018 TUITION and FEE SCHEDULE

Regular Tuition \$11,692.00 + fees

General Fee \$685.00

The general fee includes computer and library fees, yearbook, standardized tests, student insurance, Catholic Schools' Office fee, activity card and free admission to all home games and activities. New student applicants are required to pay a nonrefundable \$200.00 fee. This payment includes a \$50.00 registration fee with the balance of \$150.00 being credited toward the \$685.00 general fee. Re-enrolling students pay a \$100.00 re-enrollment fee. This payment includes a \$50.00 registration fee with the balance of \$50.00 being credited toward the \$685.00 general fee. (The remaining balance of the general fee will be included in the student's monthly tuition payments.)

Textbooks

Students for the 2017-2018 school year will receive textbooks for general courses without cost. There may be charges for some courses (refer to the 2017-2018 Course Guide). Students will receive all textbooks for the various general courses they will be taking. They are responsible for the care of all textbooks during the time that they are in possession of the books. All textbooks must be covered. **Students must pay the full cost for any damage to a book beyond normal wear and tear and for any lost or stolen books.** Books will be returned to the school prior to the last day of a course or at the close of the academic year.

Athletic/Activity

Students who participate in a sport or activity will be asked to pay an activity fee that varies depending on costs. Those students who are unable to pay this fee may apply for assistance.

Note: All policies regarding school philosophy, regulations, discipline, dress code and tuition policies are available to parents in the Parent / Student Handbook.

Financial Aid Assistance

Need based financial aid is available for financial hardship and special circumstances. Applications are available online at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/3G31V>. Completed financial assistance forms, a copy of your 2016 Federal tax return 1040, 1040A, or 1040EZ and any additional supporting documentation must be submitted to FACTS Grant and Aid (FGAA) by March 31, 2017. Applications for financial assistance must be completed each and every year.

FGAA will review all applications. All requested information is kept confidential. All required information must accompany the form or it will not be considered. The analysis and award process typically takes 45 days. Upon completion of the analysis, each family will be contacted as timely as possible by mail.

Tuition, Fee and Contract Policies

The following policies apply for delinquent tuition and fees. Only the principal can approve exceptions to these policies. If tuition cannot be paid on time, you must communicate with the principal in writing to prevent enforcement of delinquent tuition policies:

- Students may not take quarter or semester examinations with outstanding financial obligations.
- Students may not participate in graduation ceremonies with delinquent tuition or fees.
- A late fee of \$210.00 will be charged on all late Policy Contracts (due on or before May 26, 2017).
- All past due tuition and fee accounts may be assessed a late fee of \$50.00 per month.

Refunds

Students withdrawing from school on or before August 1st will receive a full refund of tuition & general fees paid less a \$200.00 administrative fee. After August 1st, portions of the contractually agreed amount and / or tuition & fees paid may be refunded or dismissed in the event of absence, withdrawal or dismissal from school depending upon the contract selection. If a Tuition Assurance Policy (TAP) is purchased, the withdrawing family's / student's financial obligation(s) to the schools will be limited to a days attended pro-ration (days attended / 180 days), plus the \$200.00 withdrawal administrative fee. If a tuition assurance plan is not selected / purchased, refunds are limited; tuition will be charged on a period-by-period basis rounded to the last day of the attended or registered quarter, plus a \$500.00 withdrawal administrative fee. In all cases, General Fees are non-refundable after August 1st. If a student withdraws and then re-enrolls within the same school year, there is a \$250.00 re-enrollment fee.
